Subject: Notification regarding Purchase of Shares in the Subsidiary Company from Krungthai Card Public

Company Limited

Krungthai Bank Public Company Limited (the "Bank" or "Krungthai") and Krungthai Card Public Company Limited ("KTC") are shareholders of Krungthai Advisory Company Limited ("KTA"), which operates a business of a holding company and is a company within the financial business group of the Bank, whereby the Bank and KTC hold shares in KTA in the proportion of 76.00 percent and 24.00 percent, respectively.

The Bank and KTC have agreed for the Bank to purchase shares in KTA, which is a subsidiary of the Bank, from KTC in the proportion of 24.00 percent, at book value according to the consolidated financial statements of KTC for the portion of KTA shares held by KTC as of December 31, 2023. The transaction will enhance the flexibility in the management and the expansion of investment of KTA.

On February 21, 2024, the Bank duly acquired the ownership of common shares of KTA in the proportion of 24.00 percent and made payment of the purchase price to KTC. Details of the transaction are as follows:
